Safer, Greener, Healthier Routes in Saffron Walden – temporary measures

FURTHER TO A NOTICE: Under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which commenced on 15 June and was continued for a further 21 days by notice on 6 July 2020.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, the Essex County Council has temporarily introduced the following measures under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (the Act), in the interests of public safety and social distancing as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday 7am to 6pm; Wednesday and Friday 8.30am to 4pm

Exemptions for emergency, maintenance and refuse vehicles, and for goods vehicle loading and unloading

Butcher Row	From its junction with Market Row to its junction with Market Street
Cross Street	From its junction with B184 Hill Street to its junction with Market Row
King Street	From its junction with B184 High Street to its junction with Market Place
Market Hill	From its junction with Church Street to its junction with Market Place
Market Row	From its junction with Cross Street to its junction with Market Street
Market Place	From its junctions with King Street, Market Hill and Market Street for its entire length

Installation of Disabled Badge Holders Only, Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6pm Maximum Stay 3 hours, No Return within 3 hours

Market Street	On its east side, from a point approximately in line with the northern kerbline of Market Row, south for 17 metres.

The existing Restricted Parking Zone No Waiting Monday to Saturday and No Loading Monday to Saturday 10am to 5pm is to be suspended for the length of this Disabled Parking Bay.

20mph Speed Limit

B184 High Street

From its junction with Gold Street northwards to a point approximately 5 metres south of its junction with Castle Street

B184 East Street

From its junction with Hill Street eastwards for 25 metres

Fairycroft Road

From its junction with East Street southwards for 7 metres

Cross Street

From its junction with B184 Hill Street to its junction with Market Row

And the entire length of the following roads

Butcher Row, Church Street, Common Hill, Emson Close, George Street, Hill Street, King Street, Market Hill, Market Place, Market Row, Market Street

These traffic measures are undertaken under “the Act” and in conjunction with additional safety improvements, are funded by national government as part of the response to the Covid-19 situation, designed to allow people more space to social distance as people move around the town centre.

Essex Highways will be replacing some of the existing temporary measures with more aesthetically pleasing semi-permanent measures including barriers, signs and cones, on routes in the town centre from **27/07/2020**. The above restrictions may be temporarily removed overnight whilst works take place to facilitate the installation of these measures.

The traffic measures under this notice may stay in force for 18 months. During this period of time a decision will be taken as to whether to make these measures permanent at this point a full public consultation will be undertaken.
