Location	Description
Water Tower Place	Formalisation of footpath and entrance for residents Still awaiting ECC confirmation of ownership
Borough Lane	Pedestrians struggle to cross the road due to oncoming traffic, they need to check all entrances to the roundabout Consider reducing size of roundabout and place an island
London Road/Debden Rd crossing onto High Street	Pedestrians struggle to cross the road due to oncoming traffic, they need to check all entrances to the roundabout Consider reducing size of roundabout and place an island
Leverett Way / Radwinter Road	High volumes of traffic at high speeds, an island to aid pedestrians in crossing
High St Crossing – Desire Line from Swan Meadow to QD	Formal crossing to aid pedestrians Still awaiting ECC confirmation if feasible or not due to demand traffic lights, but this has not been confirmed
South Road	Zebra crossing to aid pedestrians – especially school children/parents
Thaxted Road	Additional Zebra crossing toward Victoria Avenue to aid pedestrians – especially school children/parents
