We have already held a meeting at the Town Hall with Claire. Claire will set out chairs and tables and supply tea/coffee and cups and saucers. We will supply our own birthday cake and sandwiches. Our members (mostly in their 70s and 80s) are invited to attend from 2:30 pm until 4:30 pm.
What particular need do you consider the project will meet?
The project is to celebrate our 40 th birthday and to show our members that we really care for them and their continued welfare. It will be a good social occasion, many of our members live on their own and welcome such events and the social activity.

We organise Open Meetings every month when up to 100 of our members attend and listen to an arranged talk and share refreshments, a raffle and meet and greet their u3a friends and colleagues. We hire the Bowling Club in Abbey Lane for this regular event.

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We held a recruitment event in January 2024 and requested a grant from the u3a for this. They offer these grants purely for recruitment. It was a successful event and we signed up 30 people at the event – our membership rose by 62 from January's figure to February's figure, which was much applauded by the national u3a. We requested a £100 grant and were awarded this successfully. This helped towards the cost of hiring the Bowling Club and supplying bunting and refreshments.

How will you ensure that SWTC support of this project is promoted?

We will be advertising the event in our own publications and will ensure

that all our members (who are all Saffron Walden residents) will be made aware that SWTC have provided the Town Hall premises free of charge. We will also highlight this at our monthly Open Meetings.


