<p>A & S 049-24</p>	<p>Bridge End Garden</p> <p>Committee noted the written annual report as presented at the recent Friends of Bridge End Garden Annual General Meeting. Committee thanked the BEG Gardening Team for their continued efforts.</p> <p>In particular, Committee noted the decline (through use of the area and vandalism) of the hedge maze planted in 1984 and that it was common for such heavily used mazes to decline in such a manner. Professional advice was being sought regarding both short and longer-term solutions to both protect the hedge maze and bring it back into full use.</p>
