MINUTES of the FINANCE & ESTABLISHMENT COMMITTEE MEETING held in the Town Hall Saffron Walden on Monday 18 November 2024 at 7.30pm

F & E 165-24	<b>Apologies for absence</b>  Apologies were received and accepted from Cllrs Coote, Gadd, McBirnie, Meloy and Shotropa.
F & E 166-24	<b>To receive any Declarations of Interest</b>  Cllr Ahmed, Freeman and Reeve declared generic non-pecuniary interests as District Councillors for Uttlesford District Council.
F & E 167-24	<b>Public Speaking Time</b>  There were no questions arising.
F & E 168-24	<b>Minutes of the Finance &amp; Establishment Committee 21.10.2024</b>  The 21.10.2024 minutes were accepted as a true and accurate record of that meeting and were signed by the Chairman.

F & E 170-24	<b>Grant Request Citizens Advice £15k - presentation</b>  A representative of Citizens Advice explained: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. 20% of service users are based in Saffron Walden, with most queries being around fuel, council tax and water costs alongside disability benefits.</li> <li>b. CA operates with six months of reserves.</li> </ul> It was noted the monies requested are provisioned in the budget as agreed by Council. Committed thanked the representative for their time who then left the meeting.  It was <b>Resolved:</b> To grant CA with the requested £15k as provisioned for in the budget, it was noted there is no guarantee this will be provisioned for in 2025/26

F & E 171-24	<p><b>Grant Request Saffron Walden Scouts £500 – presentation</b></p> <p>A representative of Saffron Walden Scouts explained the grant request would support their project costs for a mobile range set up, as commonly requested by scout members. Committed thanked the representative for their time who then left the meeting.</p> <p>It was <b>Resolved:</b> To grant SW Scouts with £300 toward the project costs (monies to be vired from the Resilience Fund) and to provide the applicant with the UDC Ward Member Councillor details who may be able to further support the project utilising their Ward Members' Initiative Fund</p>

Include reference to the adopted disciplinary policy which may be referenced and initiated following any allegation made.</li> </ul>
