## e) Investment policy

**Committee noted:** the proposed changes copied in the policy in red font, extract below:

The RFO is authorised to place on investment a sum of up to £500,000 on a medium-term basis (up to six months) to improve the return to the Council. The RFO is authorised to place on investment a sum of up to one million pounds up to one month.

**Resolved:** To re-adopt the policy with the following revisions:

Deletion of the final paragraph named *Current Investments* and to change the proposed changes (above) to the following:

The RFO is authorised to place on investment a sum of:

- £500,000 for 12 months
- And a further £500,000 on a medium-term basis of up to six months

This is to improve the return to the Council.
