	(a) Following the election on 6 <sup>th</sup> November, Council is asked to welcome the successfully elected member of Shire Ward.
	(b) The elected Cllr will sign and return their acceptance of office prior to this Full Council meeting (11 <sup>th</sup> Nov), allowing participation in Full Council meetings in November and December. They will not have been elected to any Committees / sub-Committees, and it is recommended they adopt visitor status for November/December meetings, with no entitlement to vote.
	(c) At the January 2026 Council meeting, Council will be asked to appoint the newly elected Councillor to committee and working group membership.

#### 5 Election Arrangements for 2026/27

#### 2026

- (a) The postponed 2025 Essex County Council elections will take place on Thursday 7 May 2026 unless they are postponed again (and in effect cancelled). Members will be elected for a 2-year term until the new unitary councils are in place on 1 April 2028, which is known as "vesting day".
- (b) The new Combined Authority Mayoral election for Greater Essex will take place on the same day so there will be either a combined poll (County and Mayoral) or single poll on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2026.
- (c) From 10 November 2026, the 6-month rule will come into force which means that no more by-elections for the district or Parish Council can legally be requested to fill any subsequent vacancies that arise. In the event of a vacancy, positions may be filled by co-option

#### 2027

- (d) Subject to Local Government Reform and assuming the unitary authority representation progresses across the whole of Essex, Shadow council elections to the new councils will take place on Thursday 6 May 2027. These new members will serve a 4-year term, initially one year in shadow and then a 3-year term and then 4 yearly thereafter from 2031, being held on the same day as parish council elections.
- (e) In May 2027, the parish council elections will take place alongside the Shadow Council elections.
- (f) Existing Councillors retire on the fourth calendar day after the poll so they retire from office on Monday 10 May 2027
