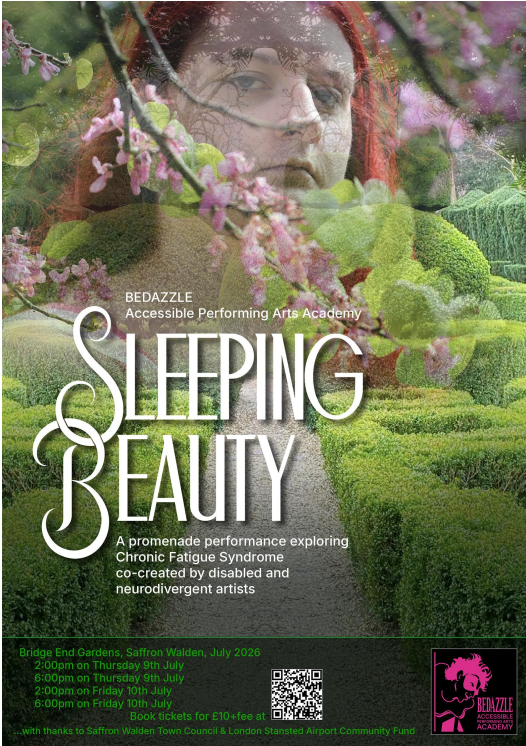

3	What was your grant for and how much was awarded from the Town Council? £1,200 in kind (free use of Bridge End Gardens venue for 2 days)
4	Objectives Tell us what the core objectives of your grant were and did you meet them? (please make reference to the information as contained within box 13 of your original grant application) The site-specific, promenade performance took place on 9th and 10th July. Due to the high heat, we cancelled one performance, following industry standards. The other three performances went off without a hitch. We welcomed approximately 105 audience members to our show. We have lots of photos from the event, and have a (currently unedited) video of the entire performance.

	Relevant feedback from audience includes: “The gardens are a real gem, aren’t they? I didn’t even know they were there, but they would be a beautiful place to read a book.” “Each scene took place in the perfect spot for the purpose of the story, and together with the beautiful costumes, props and music, it made everything even more fairytale-like.” “The whole show was amazing. Wow! Your enthusiasm and talent is just incredible.”

We threw a lot at the students - promenade performance, outdoor, and site specific were all new. The heat wave (temperatures of up to 32 degrees!) was unexpected and did make it even harder. We loved performing in the gardens. In particular, we want to thank the incredible gardeners who were so kind and supportive.

	For future projects, I would want to interact with the local community more. We intended to go flyering in the town, but the day we'd intended to go there was another heat wave and it wasn't safe to go. I would have liked to invite additional local groups - we invited several schools but none came, although we did have a disability group come. We also had a student from the local high school come to take photographs. This is a relationship we'd like to keep going.
